Branoc is a charming 57ft narrowboat, built in 2008 with a steel hull by Northwich Marina. She offers a warm, homely interior and a thoughtfully laid-out living space that's perfect for continuous cruising or comfortable liveaboard life.

The galley is a practical and well-equipped space located at the stern, with a classic cottage feel and plenty of natural light from the porthole windows. You'll find ample worktop space, a 4-ring gas cooker, fridge, microwave, washing machine, and a round sink with drainer. Open shelving and generous cabinetry make storage a breeze, and there's even space for a dining table or fold-down option for mealtimes.

Moving forward, the open-plan saloon is a cosy and inviting space. It features a full-length sofa bed, providing additional sleeping space, a comfortable leather swivel chair with footstool, a wall-mounted TV, and a solid fuel stove set against a tiled surround - perfect for creating a warm, ambient glow on chilly evenings. Built-in shelves and display units provide character and practicality. The room feels spacious and bright thanks to the over-6ft headroom and warm wood panelling throughout.

The walk-through bathroom includes a hip bath with an overhead shower, a Thetford cassette toilet (with spare), a modern sink, and even a tumble dryer. This is a generous and functional bathroom, ideal for liveaboard comfort.

At the bow is the master bedroom, which offers a fixed double bed with storage underneath, built-in wardrobes, drawers, shelving, and charming portholes dressed with curtains. There's great use of space here, providing both comfort and functionality.
