Parentis is a beautifully maintained 59ft 2" traditional narrowboat, built in 1999 by renowned boatbuilders G+J Reeves with a quality Kingsground fit out. Designed with both comfort and practicality in mind, this charming boat offers six berths and a thoughtfully laid-out interior, making her an excellent choice for families, couples, or anyone looking for extended cruising and life on the water. With a warm and inviting atmosphere, *Parentis* has everything you need to step aboard and start your adventures right away.

The galley is well equipped and provides all the facilities you'd expect for a comfortable stay. A Vanette oven and grill with a separate four-burner gas hob make cooking simple, while a Shoreline fridge and a 12v freezer (new in 2023) ensure plenty of space for provisions. A microwave adds convenience, and the stainless steel sink with draining board sits neatly alongside generous worktop space. Thoughtful storage has been built into the galley, with cupboards, shelving, and even a wine rack, ensuring everything has its place.

The lounge offers a relaxed and homely setting to unwind after a day on the waterways. Wall units and shelving provide both storage and display space, while a swivel chair with matching footstool adds a touch of comfort. Additional cupboards are also built in, keeping the living space tidy and practical.

Dining is made easy with the L-shaped dinette, which comfortably seats three to four people around the table. When required, this area cleverly converts into a double berth, providing flexible sleeping arrangements for family or guests.

Sleeping accommodation is both practical and cosy. The rear cabin is fitted with a single bed and an additional fold-down single, perfect for occasional use or extra guests. The master bedroom features a fixed double bed with two drawers underneath, providing useful storage, plus additional space behind the drawers for larger items. A wardrobe and overhead cupboards offer further storage options, while fitted reading lights add convenience and comfort.

The bathroom is well appointed with a Thetford cassette toilet, a shower, and a wash basin set into a vanity unit with storage beneath, ensuring practicality without compromising on space.

With a generous 100-gallon water tank and a reliable layout from stern to bow – starting with the engine room and rear cabin, followed by the bedroom, bathroom, dinette, galley, lounge, and finishing at the master bedroom – *Parentis* has been designed for easy living afloat.
